# Testing Tips

## Don't be late to School

Make sure that your child is in attendance during the testing sessions and has time to settle in and relax.

- Be aware of testing dates!
- Show interest in your child's schoolwork every day, not just on test days.
- *Scheduling of doctor or dental appointments: please make sure you review any appointments during testing weeks. Testing environment cannot be disturbed by calling students out of class.*
- Make sure your child gets plenty of sleep on their testing day(s).
- Make sure your child eats a healthy breakfast each day.
- Take an interest in standardized achievement tests, but don't be so concerned that you make your child nervous.
- Encourage your child to listen to ALL instructions and follow test directions carefully.
- Be positive and express confidence that your child will be able to handle the tests well.
- Encourage your child to study over several days rather than "cram" the night before.

## HELLO WILDCAT FAMILIES

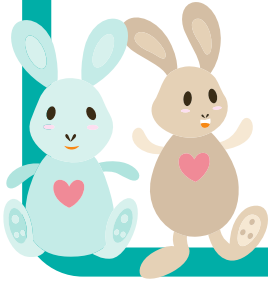
