The purpose of the award shall be to assist students who best meet our eligibility requirements in attaining higher education and achieving their career goals.

Eligibility

This award will be presented to Inland Empire School District Seniors who meet the following requirements:

1. Minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale. **Copy of unofficial transcript.**
2. Acceptance to a Vocational/Technical, Community College, or accredited four-year College or University.
3. Must have participated in 10 hours of community service and involvement in extracurricular activities.
4. One letter of recommendation is required, which cannot come from a relative or peer. (Can be provided by a teacher, clergy, school administrator, or employer)
5. The deadline for the completed application packet is Monday, April 18, 2025, at 11:59 P.M. The packet should be emailed to vettesoutwest@gmail.com Attn: Scholarship Committee.
6. Typed, double-spaced essay of at least 300 words but not to exceed (2) two pages.
Please include the essay with your application.
