- 3. Must have participated in 10 hours of community service and involvement in extracurricular activities.
- 4. One letter of recommendation is required, which cannot come from a relative or peer. (Can be provided by a teacher, clergy, school administrator, or employer)
- 5. The deadline for the completed application packet is Monday, April 18, 2025, at 11:59 P.M. The packet should be emailed to <a href="mailto:vettesoutwest@gmail.com">vettesoutwest@gmail.com</a> Attn: Scholarship Committee.
- 6. Typed, double-spaced essay of at least 300 words but not to exceed (2) two pages. **Please include the essay with your application.**
