

HOW TO CREATE YOUR STUDENTAID.GOV ACCOUNT



STUDENTS AND PARENTS SHOULD CREATE A
STUDENTAID.GOV ACCOUNT. SAVE YOUR LOGIN
INFO TO BE ABLE TO APPLY FOR THE 2025-2026
FAFSA/CADAA APPLICATION STARTING
DECEMBER 1ST.

STEP 1: GO TO CALIFORNIACOLLEGES.EDU AND SIGN IN WITH SCHOOL ACCOUNT. (RESET PASSWORD IF FORGOTTEN)

STEP 2: CLICK LAUNCH FAFSA AND CREATE AN ACCOUNT (SAVE THIS INFORMATION)

STEP 3: ENTER YOUR NAME, DATE OF BIRTH, AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

STEP 4: ENTER YOUR <u>PERSONAL</u> EMAIL, PHONE NUMBER, AND MAILING ADDRESS

STEP 5: SELECT YOUR CHALLENGE QUESTIONS AND INPUT YOUR ANSWERS

STEP 6: REVIEW AND CONFIRM YOUR INFORMATION IS CORRECT

STEP 7: VERIFY YOUR PHONE NUMBER AND EMAIL, IF AVAILABLE, AND SAVE THE BACKUP CODE PROVIDED.

STEP 8: YOUR STUDENTAID.GOV ACCOUNT HAS BEEN CREATED!

SAVE YOUR INFORMATION! YOU NEED IT TO START YOUR FAFSA
APPLICATION EVERY YEAR YOU RETURN TO COLLEGE AND APPLY FOR
FINANCIAL AID.

FAFSA ONLINE STEP-BY-STEP



STUDENTS AND PARENTS SHOULD CREATE AN FSA ID.
SAVE YOUR LOGIN INFO AS YOU WILL NEED IT TO
START YOUR FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION (FAFSA).

- 1.) GO TO HTTPS://STUDENTAID.GOV/ AND "CREATE ACCOUNT"
- 2.) CREATE AN FSA ID, CLICK ON "GET STARTED,* AND COMPLETE STEPS 1-7

<u>DOCUMENTS NEEDED</u> - SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER/CARD *NOTE: USE PERSONAL EMAIL • NAME AND NUMBER ON SOCIAL SECURITY CARD MUST MATCH THE INFORMATION ENTERED

- 3.) VERIFY EMAIL/PHONE NUMBER.
- 4.) START THE FAFSA APPLICATION- GO TO LOGIN FAFSA ON THE WEB FEDERAL STUDENT AID *CLICK "I AM THE STUDENT"
- 5.) ENTER YOUR FSA ID (USERNAME) AND PASSWORD
- 6.) SELECT THE 2025-2026 APPLICATION IF YOU WILL ATTEND COLLEGE BETWEEN JUNE 1, 2025 AND JULY 30,
- 2025. *IF YOU ARE STARTING IN THE SUMMER AFTER GRADUATION, YOU WILL NEED TO FILL OUT BOTH 2024-
- **2025 AND 2025-2026 APPLICATIONS.**
- 7) THE FAFSA ITSELF IS BROKEN INTO SEVEN SECTIONS: STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS, SCHOOL SELECTION, DEPENDENCY STATUS, PARENT DEMOGRAPHICS, FINANCIAL INFORMATION, SIGN AND SUBMIT, AND CONFIRMATION.
- ightarrow COMPLETE EACH OF THESE SECTIONS CAREFULLY, MAKING SURE THAT THE INFORMATION IS ACCURATE
- *NOTE: PARENTS/GUARDIANS WILL NEED TO CREATE THEIR OWN FSA ID (SAME STEP AS ABOVE), BUT ONLY THE STUDENT COMPLETES THE FAFSA APPLICATION.
- → IRS DATA RETRIEVAL TOOL (IRS DRT) ALLOWS STUDENTS AND PARENTS WHO FILED A U.S. TAX RETURN WITH THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE (IRS) TO ACCESS THE IRS TAX RETURN INFORMATION NEEDED TO COMPLETE THE FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA*) FORM AND TO TRANSFER THE DATA DIRECTLY INTO THEIR FAFSA FORM.

FAFSA CHECKLIST

Follow these steps to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year to apply for most types of financial aid.



Determine if you are an independent or dependent student

Independent: only report information about yourself and not your parent(s) **Dependent:** report information about yourself and your parent(s) — most common

You are an **independent** student if at least **one** of the following is true about you:

- You will be 24 years of age or older as of Jan 2025 You
- have a child or other dependent for whom you provide the majority of financial support
- You have a court-ordered legal guardian who is not your biological or adoptive parent
- You were in foster care at any point after age 13

- You were a ward of the court at any point after age 13
- You are married (but not separated or divorced)
- You are homeless or at risk of being homeless
- Your parents are incarcerated or deceased
- You are currently on active duty or are a veteran of the U.S. armed forces

If none of the above apply, you're a **dependent** student. If special circumstances prevent you from providing parental information, contact your college financial aid office.



All students need to collect the following information

Gather as many items on the list as you can, even if you're unable to collect them all.

Student FSA ID username and password
Picture or copy of your social security card (if applicable)
Picture or copy of your green card (if applicable)
Your 2023 federal tax forms (if applicable)
Total current amount in your checking and savings accounts: \$
Net worth of your investments: \$
List of colleges you will apply to or current college you will continue attending



If you're a dependent student, collect this info for your parent(s). If your parents are divorced/separated, include info about the parent who provides the majority of your financial support. If that parent is remarried, include your stepparent.
