Scripting Sheets (Practice samples; turn your story into a performance script!)

1. Read through the story silently.
2. As a group, identify the roles in the story and divide them among you.
3. Go over the story together, deciding who will read what and also what to cut. On your own sheet, in pencil, cross out the cuts and underline your own speeches
4. Try out your script by reading together. Go back and change it as needed.
