- STATION 1 Online Data Confirmation: The online data confirmation window open on July 27th August 7th.

- STATION 2 Book/Device Return and Fees: Parents/students will be notified if they have outstanding fees either from un-returned library books, textbooks, or other unpaid financial obligations. - STATION 3 Student Handbook: Please view the virtual copy of our student handbook which is available as a pdf on our website. Students will receive a copy of the handbook their first day on campus.
- STATION 4 Student Schedule Pick-up: All schedules will be released to view on the student/parent Aeries Portal on Monday August 3rd. There will be a link on our counseling webpage to request a course change. (Please review the course change policy in the handbook.)
- STATION 5 Purchases: Only Foreign Language Workbooks will be sold at this time. Please access our online bookkeeper to make this transaction. YOU MUST BRING YOUR RECEIPT in order to receive your workbook during textbook pick up! We hope to offer for purchase ASB, Parking Permits, & Yearbooks later in the school year, as permitted. - STATION 6 Photo ID: ID Photos will take place virtually through Cherished Memorize Photography. Students will be sent a personalized link to upload a personal selfie-photo. ID distribution date TBD.
- ▼ STATION 7 Student Forms: The following forms must be submitted via email or in person to your counselor:
 - Grade 11 & 12 students not taking PE, must download the PE Waiver Form, sign and complete.
 - Students taking TA (Teacher Assistant), Late Start, or Early Release must download the appropriate form, sign and complete. <u>Access Student Forms Here</u>
- STATION 8 Nutrition Services: Please visit our Nutrition Services website to create lunch accounts, add funds, or complete the reduced lunch request form.
