Brief Course Description: Leadership is designed for the student interested in learning the basic concepts of democratic government in a laboratory of practical school situations. The student will have opportunities to develop speaking and writing skills, to work with administration, to develop the ASB budget, and plan and develop a variety of school activities including assemblies, dances and class competitions. Students will be required to attend after school activities when scheduled.
