Sweater weather

As we approach the end of the year, we want to celebrate the diverse holidays that our school community observes. Here are some of the special holidays during this season:

Christmas - December 25

Christmas is celebrated by Christians around the world to honor the birth of Jesus Christ. Traditions include decorating Christmas trees, exchanging gifts, and sharing meals with loved ones.

Hanukkah - December 25

Hanukkah, also known as the Festival of Lights, is an eight-day Jewish holiday. It commemorates the rededication of the Second Temple in Jerusalem. Families light a menorah, play games like dreidel, and enjoy foods like latkes (potato pancakes).

Kwanzaa - December 26 - January 1

Kwanzaa is a celebration of African-American culture and heritage. It lasts for seven days, each dedicated to one of the seven principles. Families light a kinara (candle holder) and enjoy music, dance, and storytelling.

Las Posadas December 16 - 24

Las Posadas is a nine-day celebration observed in Mexico and some Latin American countries. It reenacts Mary and Joseph's search for shelter before the birth of Jesus. Each night, families participate in processions, sing carols, and enjoy festive foods

SEL Focus: Peer Relations

School Counseling Lessons will focus on peer relations. Lesson will discuss sharing, trading, and taking turns to promote fairness and mutual enjoyment. Students will learn how to apply problemsolving skills to scenarios that involve playground or peer conflict. 
