Using the idea worksheet from prereading for "A Modest Proposal," you are to compose your own satirical essay in the style of Swift's "A Modest Proposal" in an attempt to persuade readers to agree with your opinion. Remember, YOUR OPINION IS ACTUALLY THE OPPOSITE OF WHAT YOU BELIEVE. Include the "benefits" (which are actually CONS) to the problem, and clearly explain the target population(s) affected by the problem (in this case, they are the ones who benefit from the problem). Think about the teacher's problem of people who cut her off while driving. In her proposal, she would actually encourage people to cut her off and explain the REVERSE benefits, solutions, etc. Try to incorporate one satirical element such as overstatement, exaggeration, etc.

Your **PROPOSAL** must be at LEAST 3 paragraphs long. It must be typed and double line spaced; however, font size, color, and style is up to you for this assignment. Use adjectives, details, and explanations to persuade your reader that YOUR VIEW is correct. You may stray from the typical "5

paragraph essay" format for this assignment, since it is of a more creative nature. Your PROPOSAL will
